

Section 11 Annex

The collection of memorial inscriptions at the cemetery has been undertaken before but not published. The results are a summary of the inscriptions, rather than the inscriptions themselves, and the list is alphabetical mainly, but not always, according to the first surname on the inscription. There is no indication of the location of each grave. The material seems to have been gathered in 1997 as latest date found is from 1996 and it omits a grave from 1998 which would have been known as it was of the Abbey's rector.

A reconciliation between the names has been undertaken to determine missing information arising from the deterioration of the graves. Even though the graves may not be found, it allows relatives to determine that someone is buried in the cemetery and that further searching at other cemeteries is unnecessary. Where necessary, transcription errors discovered by checking against death registrations have been corrected. The grouping of the names in the 1997 list allows identification of the possible graves where additional information might be present. The following table lists this additional information which has yet to be found, identifying the graves where this would be expected. There are about 30 graves for which identification has not been possible, probably due to weathering or delamination.
