

Section V

This section is in the north-western part of the cemetery. The northern part is on level ground by the chapel, the southern part ascending the hill west of the chapel. The alignment of the graves by the chapel do not conform to the grid used for the rest of the section.

The area has 229 graves but less than a quarter have memorials.

The area next to the western boundary wall has laurel bushes.

Some anomalies have been discovered in the reconciliation of the positions of graves, as given in the burial book, and their actual locations. These are concerned with the southern area near the chapel and are:

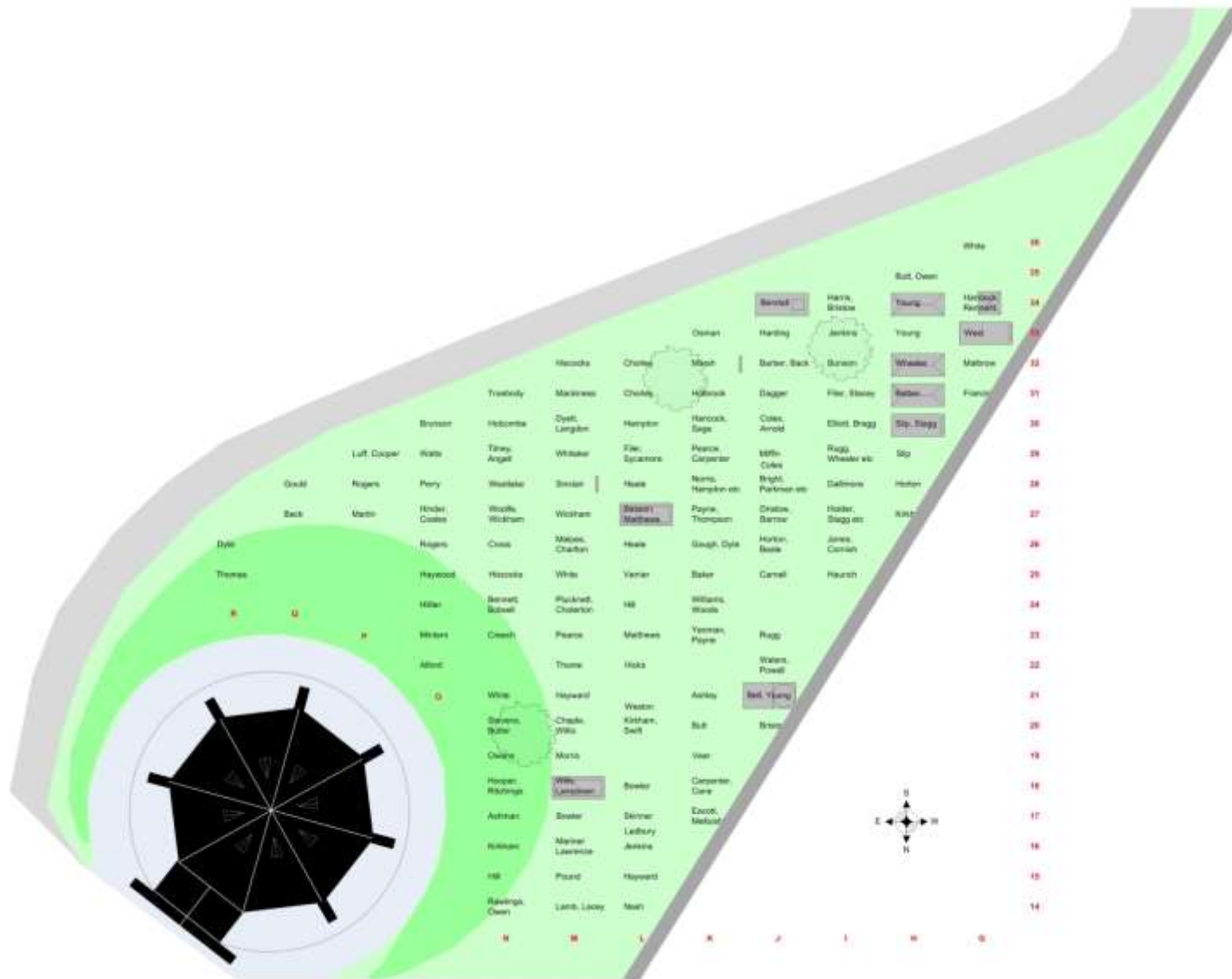
- The Sissons grave is given as being at P.5 but is actually located at O.12.
- The distance from the western side of the Sissons grave to the western wall is about 12', a distance which would not allow for the inclusion of both rows L and M if they were both 7' long with an 18" gap.
- The distance from the northern side of the Sissons grave to the northern wall is about 27' and this is insufficient to accommodate the 9 graves that are meant to be in this space if each has a width of 3' and a gap of 6" between each one.
- The Gregory, Parr grave is given as O.8 but was found west of the Sissons grave in an area corresponding to N.14
- The Kirkham grave given as at O.6 was found west of the Sissons grave in an area corresponding to N.12.
- The distance from the Thomas grave at the western end of Row R to the western boundary wall is 12'. This space is meant to include 4 graves at positions 1, 2, 4 and 5. However, the width does not allow for 5 plots.
