- Headstone for someone born before 1780
- Church (or other place of worship) without a tower
- Dedication on a bench

- Speed limit signpost
- Blue door – where does it lead?
- Cat – do you know its name?
- Wooden fence
- Body of water (river, canal, lake, pond, puddle)
- Industrial building (the oldest one you can find) – what's it/was used for?
