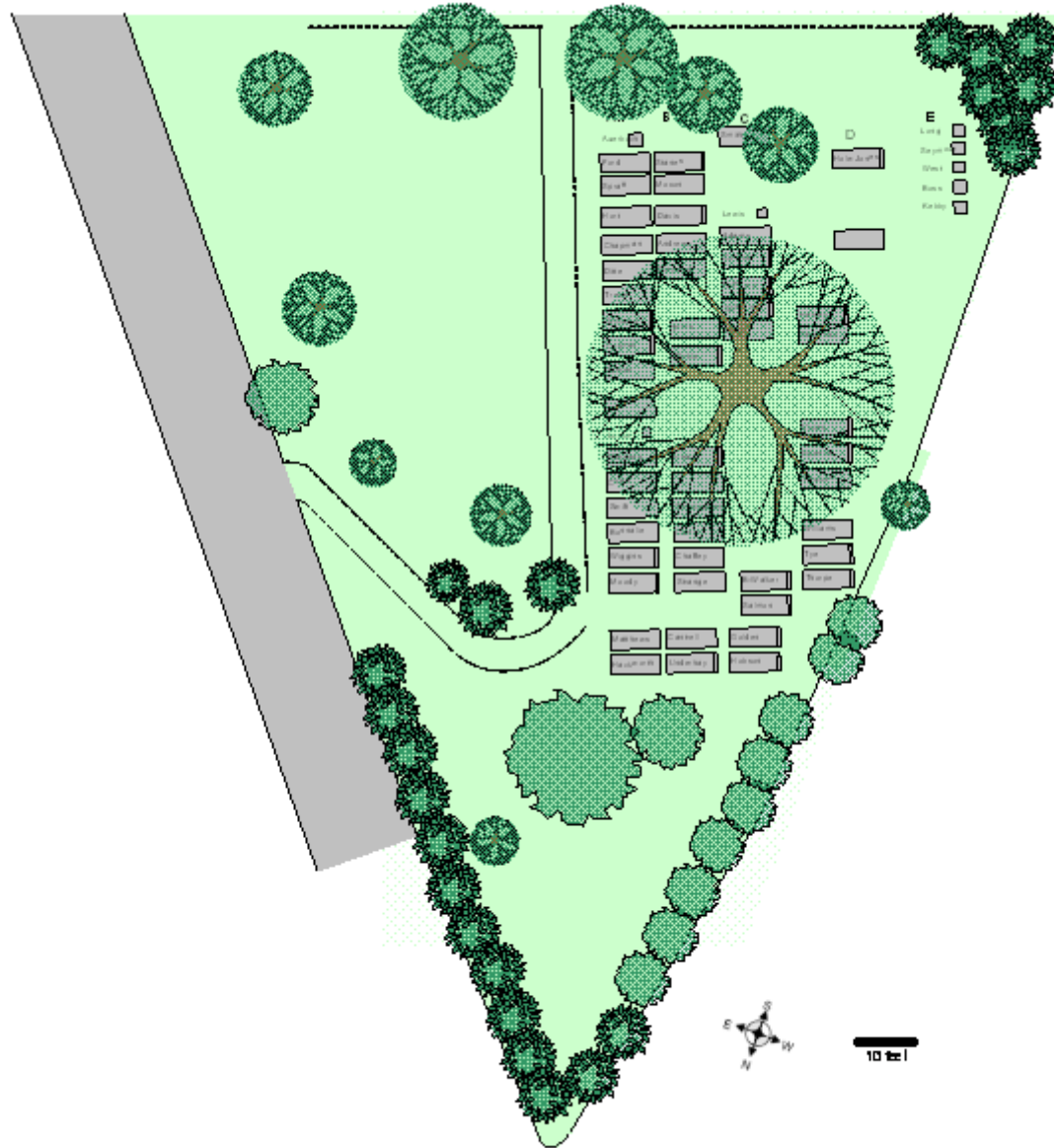


**Section 9 Garden**

The area called 'The Garden' was, according to the original plans, intended to be part of a garden at the lowest, northernmost part of the cemetery. Parts on the eastern side are steep and have not been used for graves. However, the area under the trees has been used from the 1970s for various graves on the western side of the main path. The graves are arranged in five rows. Here they are given letters A through D starting at A closest to the path and the numbering within a row starts with 1 at the uppermost level.
