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Introduction



The church of St Mary, Laverton

For a history of the church see the website for the Hardington Vale Benefice which includes six churches in the neighbourhood.

From *The Frome Times* of Wed 11 Aug 1859 p4:
Laverton.

On Saturday last, August 27th, the Parish Church of this village was re-opened, after having been closed some time for the purpose of making considerable alterations and improvements. The old gallery has been taken down, the lofty pews removed and replaced by open stalls, a new pulpit and reading desk in carved oak, and a lettern (sic) have also been added, and the whole of the interior considerably beautified. The entire portion of the new fittings have been executed from the designs of Messrs. Brown and Sons, and appeared to give great satisfaction to the Reverend the Rector and his

friends. The Church was decorated with exquisite taste and effect by the ladies of the Rector's family, the font being encircled with wreaths of flowers. . . . After the service was over the Rev. Russell entertained a party of 50 to dinner at the Rectory. We hear that the Bishop of Bath and Wells had been invited, but was unable to attend.

From *The Frome Times* of Wed 11 Aug 1859 p4:
Some apples have been grown from a graft in the Rectory garden of Laverton, measuring from a foot to thirteen inches and a half in circumference, and weigh more than 1lb.

From *The Frome Times* of Wed 27 May 1868 p2:
On Easter-day, a handsome east window (by Messrs. Horwood, of Frome), was placed in the Church at Laverton, to the memory of Rev. G. Rous, and some members of the family of the present Rector.

From *The Frome Times* of Wed 10 Aug 1881 p3:
This outbreak of scarlet fever in the Road sub-district points to something radically wrong in the sanitary conditions of the place affected, and should obtain the careful attention of the Sanitary Authority. Of the seven deaths from scarlet fever, five occurred in the parish of Laverton and two in Beckington.

(The burial register has the burial of six children between the ages of 3 and 7 in May-Aug 1881. A charge of negligence was brought by the rector against a medical officer of the Frome Union, this relating to a case of scarlet fever.)

References to Laverton in the local press in the 19th century are mainly to do with the sale of property,

the occasional fire, assault, burglary, fines for trespassing in search of game, in 1839 a petition for the commutation of tithes.



The church was Grade II* listed in 1968. The description given is: 'Parish church. C11, predominantly C15, restored late C19. Random rubble, slate and stone tile roofs. Perpendicular. West tower with a saddleback roof, prominent buttresses with offsets, 3-light mullioned windows high up on west wall, above it a clock; a lancet and a 2 light window to north and south sides. Buttressed single bay nave; 3 light windows; blocked south door; north door in a C11 surround, one order of scallop capitals, zig zag decoration to head. Buttressed chancel of one bay, 2 light window to south side; restored 3-light east window; priests door in a hollow moulded stone surround. Interior on tile floors, ceiled wagon roof of C19 to nave, upper and lower entrances to the rood loft, some C19 stained glass. Classical wall monument of 1691 to

John Yerbury, flanking columns, broken segmental pediment with a coat of arms.’
The Farewell chest tomb was Grade II listed in 1984 described as ‘Chest tomb to John Farewell. Dated 1682. Ashlar. Chest with corner pilasters and central pilaster strip to each side; recessed stone panel to each end with dentil decoration around edge. Dedicatory inscription on West end. Slab top.’

Burial Registers

Somerset Heritage Centre has no burial registers for Laverton. The register from 1813- is with the parish. In common with other parishes, new burial registers, more atuned to the information requirements, were introduced in 1995.

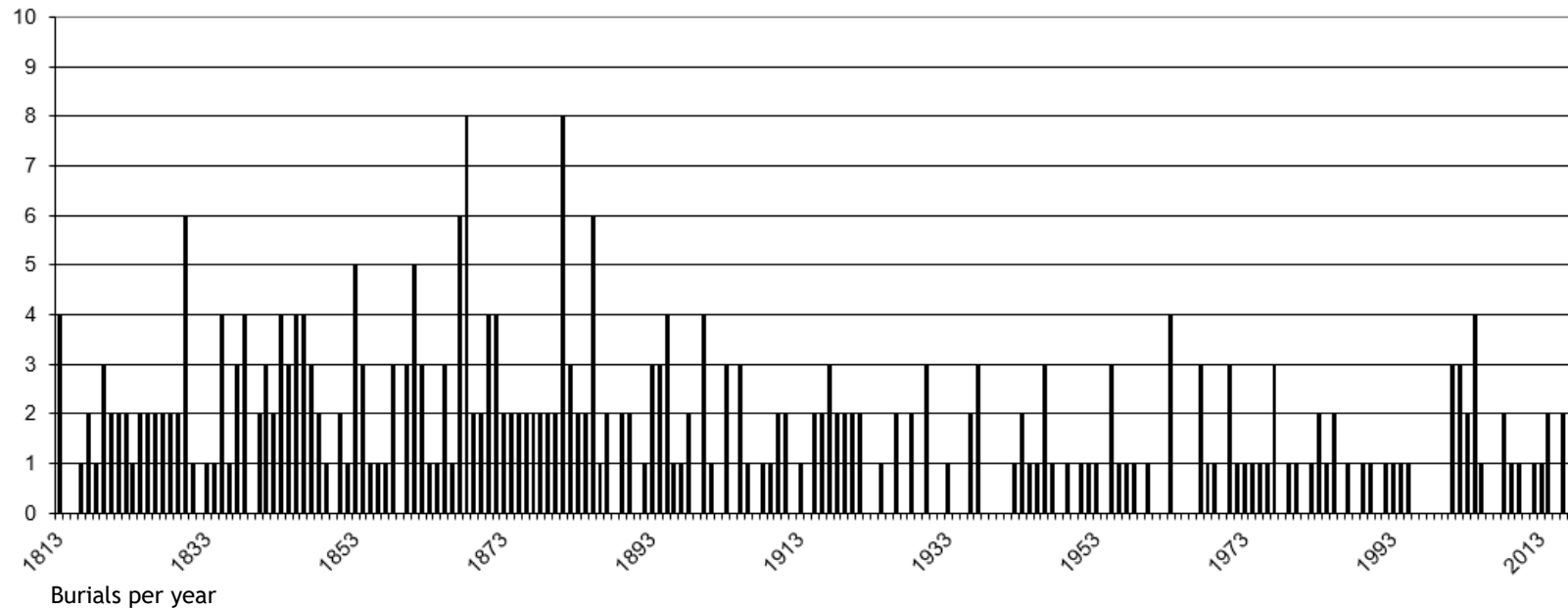
Previous Survey

A survey was carried out in November 2006 by a survey team from The Bath & Camerton Archaeological Society and a church team. This used

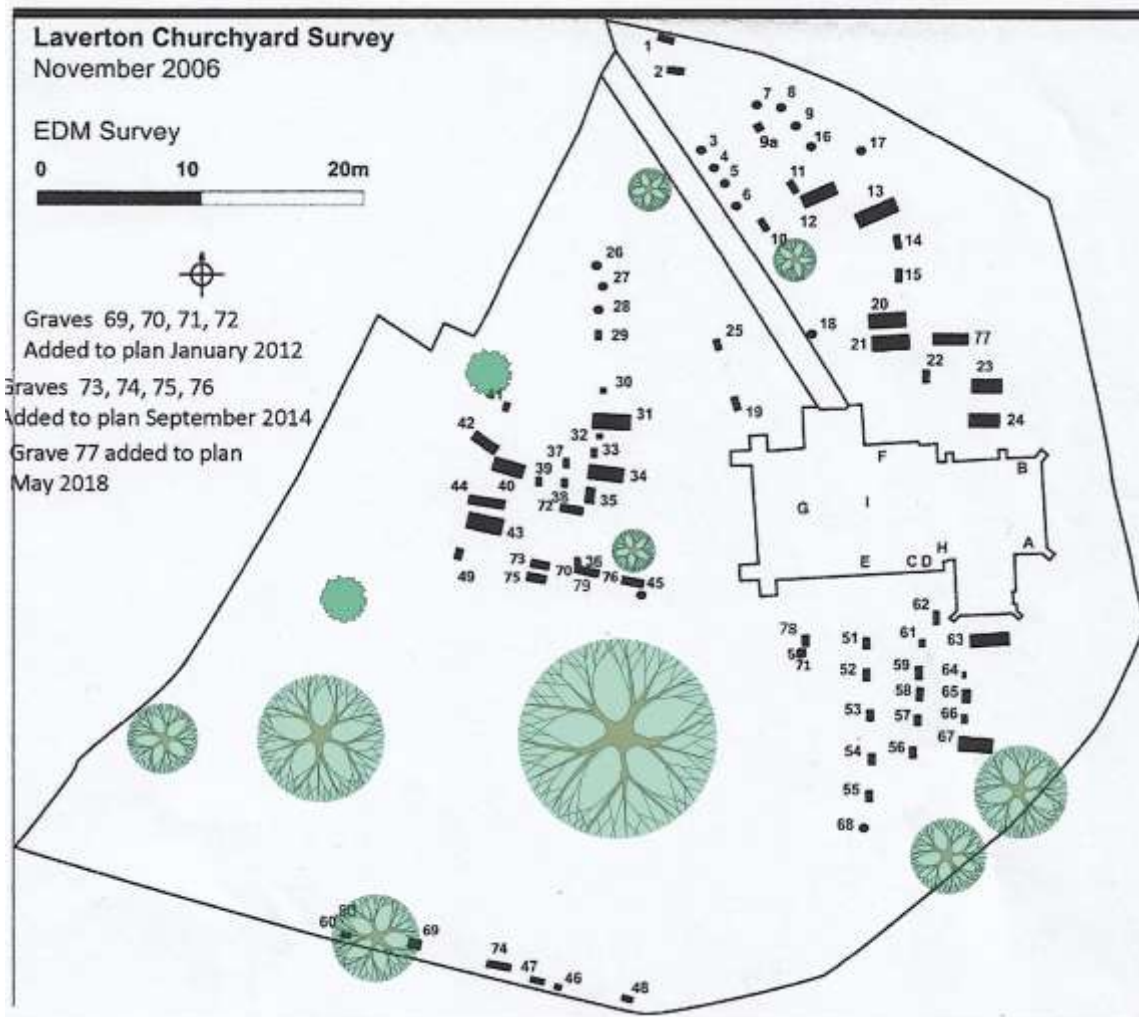
an electronic theodolite, a resistance meter and a magnetometer to identify subsurface features.

This interment was followed not long after by his son who was the victim of a shooting accident and then his wife. When William died in 1889 his obituary described him as an early Colonist of Victoria who arrived in 1840 with his family on the barque Andromache and who eventually settled at what he called Hobson’s River Farm just west of Yarraville.
