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Introduction



The church of St Peter, Marksbury

From the *Bristol Mirror* of Sat 29 Dec 1810 p3: "On Tuesday last we were visited by one of the most dreadful storms ever remembered in this season of the year.... A considerable portion of the north-west pinnacle of the tower of Marksbury church, was blown down during the storm."

From the *Bath Chronicle* of Thu 1 Aug 1889 p2: RE-OPENING OF MARKSBURY CHURCH. — The parish church, which is very old, and consequently rather dilapidated, has, for the past few weeks been under

repair. At the Easter vestry it was decided to strip the roof and replace about half the old slates with new ones, put new ridge crease and a new ceiling, and colour the walls. This has been done and, in addition, the porch has been rebuilt, the buttresses renewed, the north and west walls of the nave and tower pointed, and the boundary walls made good, whilst new ropes have been put to the bells. The church was re-opened for worship on Sunday, the Rector (Rev. T. J. Scott) conducting the service. In the morning the proper Psalms were 26, 27, and 48; the lessons were taken from Gen. xxvii., 10 and 1 Peter ii; hymns 242, 213 and 173 were sung and a most appropriate sermon preached from 1 Peter ii. 4, "to whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen by God and precious." The proper Psalms in the evening were 84, 122 and 150; lessons 2 Chron, Xxix., 20, and Rev. xxi.; hymns 240, 215 and 166: and the sermon from Rev. xxi. 5, "behold I make all thins new." During both sermons the Rector made reference to the work which had just been done, and earnestly appealed for contributions towards defraying the cist. It is satisfactory to known that the necessary amount has been collected with the exception of about £30, which it is hoped may be soon forthcoming.

From the *Bath Chronicle* of Thu 5 Jan 1893 p6: "Mr. F. W. L. Popham, patron of the living, has presented to Marksbury Church a two manual American organ."

From the start of the burial register 1813-1981: Tuesday 21st October 1902

The additional piece of land which was given by Mr Francis William Leyborne Popham as an addition to the Old Churchyard in the year 1886 (conveyance dated 13th March 1886) was solemnly consecrated on Tuesday 21st October 1902 by the Right Reverend George Wynham Kennion D.D. Lord Bishop of Bath & Wells. The Petition for Consecration was signed by almost every householder in the Parish and there was a unanimous desire in the part of the Parishioners for the Consecration Service being performed. The Venerable H Bothamley M.A. Archdeacon of Bath was in attendance on the Bishop. . . .

In 2017 repairs were carried out on the tower roof and walls, this being completed in October. The bells are to be reinstalled on a new bell-frame.

The parish is part of the benefice of Farmborough, Marksbury and Stanton Prior within the archdeaconry of Bath.
