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Scope: This document contains transcriptions of inscriptions in the consecrated section of St Michael's Cemetery, Lower Weston, Bath. The major survey was carried out in December 2013 and February 2014. In August 2016 some further checks were made on those inscriptions which were difficult to read.

Updates: The inscription on the memorial at C.D.3-4 has been updated as a result of the memorial being cleaned and re-erected and new text added.
