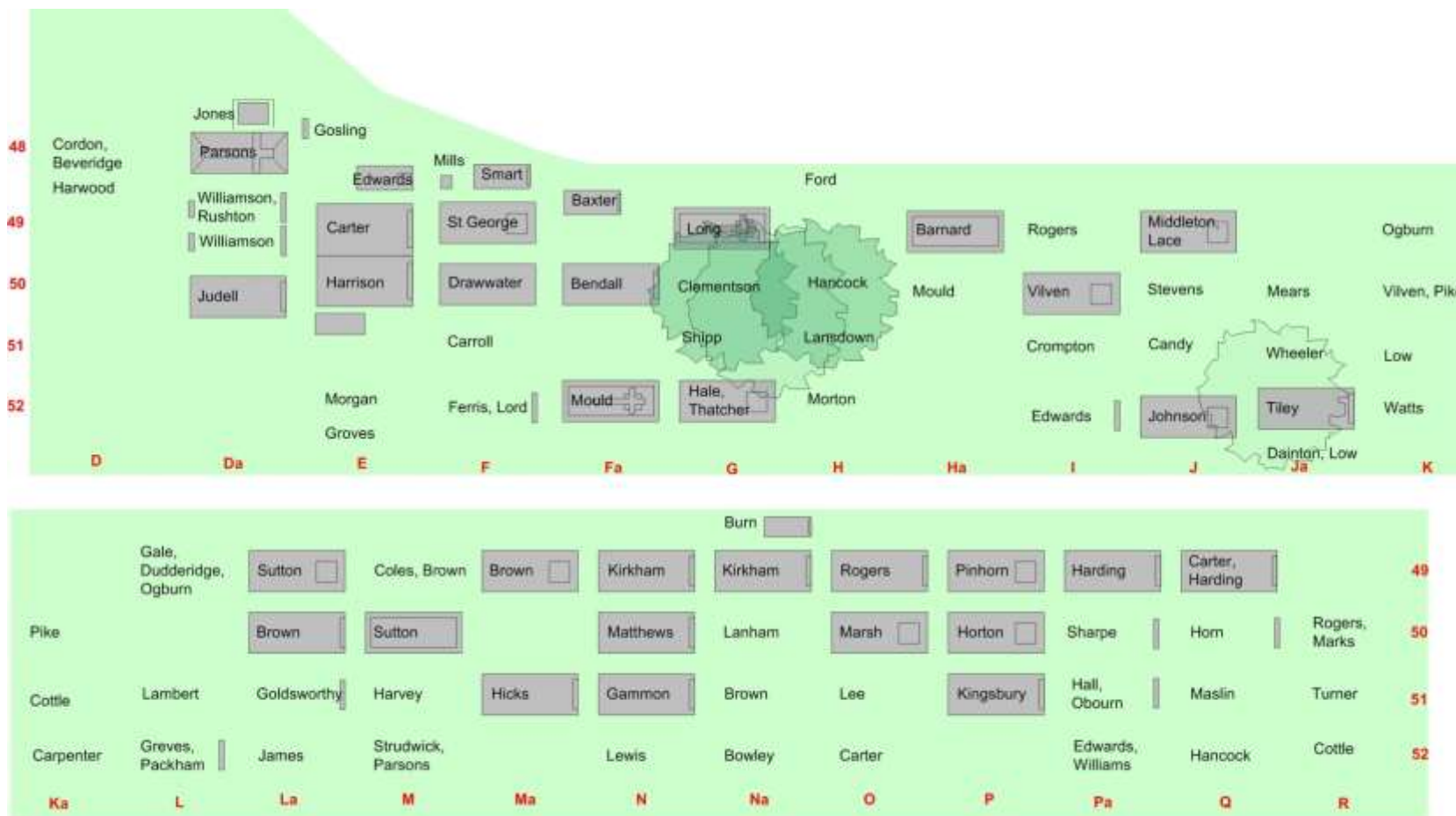


Section E

This section is on the left-hand side after entering the cemetery. It contains 76 graves with 48 memorials. It is bounded on the northern side by the boundary wall. The gap between rows is variable between 1' and 2'.

There are some child graves at the eastern end which don't conform to the general layout.
