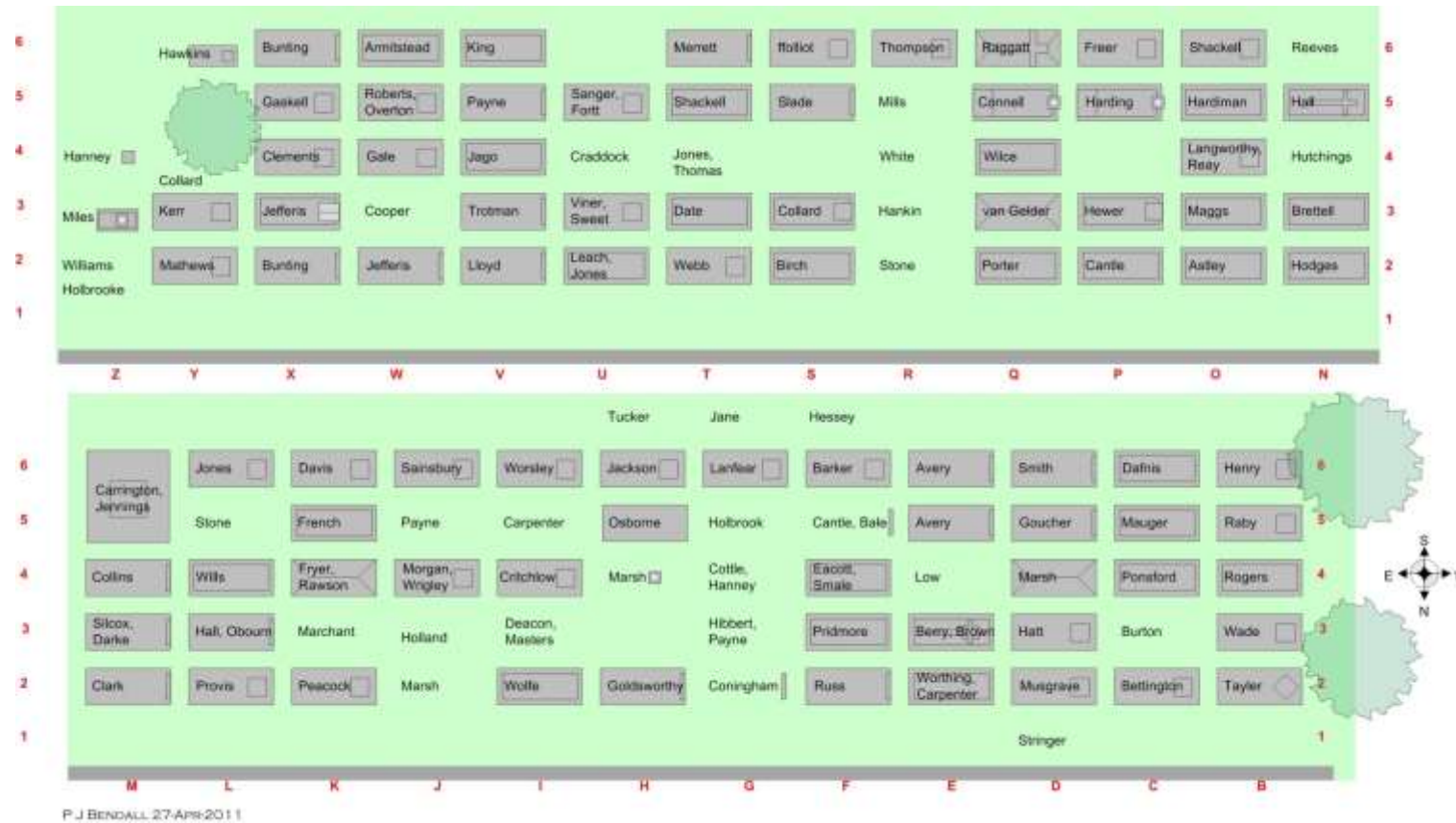


## Section L

Section L runs along the northern edge of the post-1907 area. In theory it has 6 plots per row but in practice there is usually one unmarked grave in the position numbered 1, by the boundary wall. There are 116 graves and 94 memorials. Row B is at the western end, closest to the gate.
