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

Introduction



The church of All Saints, Tellisford

The parish of All Saints, Tellisford was part of the Parish of Rode Major (Rode, Farleigh Hungerford, Tellisford. In 2007 these three churches along with Norton St Philip, St Mary's Hemington and St Mary's, Laverton united to form one Parish (the Hardington Vale benefice), part of the Deanery of Frome, in the Wells Archdeaconry within the Diocese of Bath & Wells.

From The National Gazetteer of Great Britain and Ireland (1868) p624:

TELLISFORD, a par. in the hundred of Wellow, co. Somerset, 6 miles N.E. of Frome, its post town, and 6 S.W. of Freshford railway station. The village is situated at the bridge over the river Frome, which here separates this co. from that of Wiltshire. About a third part of the village was burnt in 1785. The soil consists of clay and loam. In the vicinity is a fulling

mill. The living is a rect. in the dioc. of Bath and Wells, val. £173. The church, dedicated to All Saints, is an ancient structure with a tower containing three bells, and has recently been restored. The parochial charities produce about £4 per annum. There is a school with a small endowment.

The following notice appeared in the *Bath Chronicle* of Thu 19 May 1785 p3:

THE FIRE that lately happened at TELLISFORD, a small village near Phillip's-Norton, in the county of Somerset, and reduced to ashes six dwelling houses, (three of them the property of three poor men also a very considerable part of the household goods, wearing apparel, working tools, &c, of six poor families, calls for the charitable Contributions of the Compassionate.

An estimate, amounting to One Hundred and Twentyseven Pounds and Nineteen Shillings, has been taken from the poor sufferers; the chief particulars of which will be presented for inspection.

It is humbly hoped, the Benevolent will communicate the distressed situation of these unfortunate men and their families, who are unable to bear their respective losses; and in whose behalf therefore two Clergymen, who well known the unhappy sufferers, intend personally to solicit Charitable Donations of the Nobility and Gentry of this City.

The fulling mill referred to is on the river Frome. It later became a corn mill and in 1895 had a water turbine. After nearly a century of being abandoned and falling into ruins, it was converted over a number of years into a micro-electricity generating station.

The school and its small endowment referred to have an echo in a memorial in the church for Edward

Crabb (1745-1810) who bequeathed £100 'for the education of the poor of this parish'.

Tellisford is a 'thankful village', one from which all members of the armed forces returned after World War I. Nine such villages have been identified for Somerset and about 50 in all of England.



The church was Grade II listed in 1968. Unlike many churches in the area, it was not extended in the 19th century with aisles and consists of a western tower, a nave, a chancel (with organ) and sanctuary. On the northern side is a vestry. The National Gazetteer entry of 1868 refers to it as having been 'recently restored'.

From Primitive Sub Dials or Scratch Dials Containing a Lust of those in Somerset by Dom Ethelbert Horne (Taunton, 1917):

TELLISFORD CHURCH

49. (1) This dial is on the W. side of the S.. porch. It is 4 feet 8 inches above the ground, the noonline is 2 inches in length, the stylehole is $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch in depth, and the aspect is S. by 5° E.. Type 3.

Tellisford - Memorial Inscriptions

50. (2) This dial is on the W. side of the S. porch. It is 3 feet 8 inches above the ground, the noonline is $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches in length, the stylehole is $\frac{1}{6}$ of an inch in depth, and the aspects is the same as No. 1. Type 4.

51. (3) This dial is on the E. side of the S. porch. It is 5 feet and 8 inches above the ground, the noonline is 3½ inches in length, the stylehole is filled up, and the aspect is the same as No. 1. Type 4. June 17th, 1913.

Dial No. 1 is probably in its primitive state, and is a good example of a mass dial. No. 2 has been much mutilated and made into a wheel. No. 3 appears to have had many lines added to it, and it is difficult to say which are the original.


